Dear parents/guardians, staff and students,

We write in connection with our schools' joint production of **Calamity Jane** this week.

The cast and production team have been rehearsing for this show since September and are now on the verge of delivering a very enjoyable production for our entertainment. We thank them for their wonderful commitment and adherence to public health guidelines at all stages.

The run of the show, however, coincides with new government regulations that see, among other items, a 50% capacity on indoor entertainment venues.

In order not to disappoint our cast, production team and audience, and to comply with all public health regulations, we have decided to run the show over four nights – Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday, 7,8,9 and 11 December with a 7.30 p.m. start each evening. We are most grateful to the staff in the National Opera House for their assistance in this regard.

This is where we now need your understanding and help. We require approximately 100 people who are booked for Wednesday and 200 who have a booking for Thursday to now change, if at all possible, to Saturday's performance. The change can be made by contacting the National Opera House box office at 053-9122144, open from 9.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. each weekday. If you are in a position to facilitate this change – we urge you to do so as soon as possible.

If you have not had the opportunity to book any seats yet – please contact the box office as there will be a limited number of new tickets also available for the new Saturday night performance.

If you can help us with this, we ask you to do so without delay so that each show can run safely with a maximum 50% capacity. We also appeal to patrons to co-operate with National Opera House staff who may need to adjust the seating plan to comply with new regulations. Your patience and understanding would be greatly appreciated.

We will be keeping the situation under constant review in the coming days and will contact you again, if necessary.

We thank you in anticipation of your assistance with this matter.
